Future Construction Projects

Wylie NE SUD is growing. With growth comes construction. Wylie NE plans to build another pump station on the southwest side of the Inspiration property. This pump station will help us meet water demands on the north side of our system. We will also upgrade our pumps and motors at our office pump station site. These projects will start after we receive approval from the State of Texas.

With the population boom in our area, the Texas Dept. of Transportation will widen Parker Rd. Wylie NE SUD will be required to move our water lines to accommodate the construction. Wylie NE SUD will use this opportunity to install larger pipes to help with the increased water demands in our system. This construction will start after we have received plans from the Texas Dept. of Transportation (TxDOT).

North Texas Municipal Water District, our water supplier, will start construction of the Lower Bois D Arc Reservoir, in Bonham, TX, in May 2018. It is planned to have the lake online to supply water to our region by 2022. NTMWD is also constructing a pump station on the Trinity River. This pump station will pump water from the Trinity River to the north side of Lake Lavon. Construction should be completed by 2019.

Growth In Our Water System

Our area is growing quickly. In 2017, our water supply company added 221 new homes and a new elementary school to our water system. We are expecting the trend of new homes being built in our area to continue in 2018. Wylie NE SUD is working hard with our professional associates to keep up with the demands. We look forward to growing with our surrounding communities in 2018.

Protect your pipes

As we head into the coldest part of the year, be sure to cover your exposed pipes and outdoor faucets. Try to keep your garage door closed to protect the hot water heater and the lines coming out of it. Make sure the water meter box and all irrigation control boxes in the yard are closed securely.
